- Praesidium Presentation
 - Deadline to complete the Know Your Score re-assessment tool is April 29, 2016
 - Four webinars will be available in March The first three will focus on new re-assessment tool features; the last one will be comprehensive for new providers. Webinars will review best practice for taking the assessment tool, information about online trainings available to the network, scoring scenarios, how to apply the information to your organization, and a Q&A demo.
 - Purpose of the re-assessment tool increase scores for each operation and as a network. Will includes a comprehensive "What's Next?" report, online cost-benefit matrix to prioritize an action plan, and printable resources to help close gaps.
